

# Measurement Guide

## **How to find your perfect size**

To feel completely comfortable, your clothing needs to fit just right.  
With the help of the size charts and tips below, you can easily find your ideal size.  
Please note the separate size information for wellness trousers and jeans.



- 1 Chest measurement
- 2 Hip measurement
- 3 Waist measurement

All sizes are carefully developed, including larger sizes. The materials are slightly stretchy and very comfortable. The half width measurements increase by +4 cm for tops and by +3 cm for trousers per order size for both women and men. The total length increases by +1.5 cm. The sleeve length of women's short-sleeved shirts increases by approximately 2 cm per size. The waist tapering of women's shirts is significantly reduced in larger sizes.

**Correct measuring:**

Bust: Measure horizontally around the fullest part of your bust.

Hips: Measure horizontally at the widest point of your hips.

Waist: Measure at the level of your trouser waistband.
